Public Law 16-51 (effective Jan. 15, 2010), the “Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation Act of 2008,” codified at 3 CMC § 2801 et seq., established the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation, which assumed the duties of the Department of Public Health as of January 15, 2011.

In January, 2019, 41 Com. Reg. 041326 (Jan. 28, 2019), the Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation adopted its proposed regulations that had been published at 40 Com. Reg. 041013 (Nov. 28, 2018) and specifically provided that the “current NMIAC Subchapter 140-10.8, Schedule of Medical and Other Related Fees will be repealed and replaced in its entirety. Part 100 will be the new Chargemaster. Part 200 will be the new Bureau of Environmental Health Fees.” In codifying the adoption of the repeal and replacement, the Commission reserved Part 100 for consistency, provided section numbers within the parts, and maintained the source history for the subchapter and § 140-10.8-101 for reference. The Commission removed the source history for § 140-10.8-201, as it is unrelated to the

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new section and new Part 200. The Commission also removed historical comments that are not directly relevant after the repeal and replacement.
