§ 3710. Indexing and Recording Old Documents or Books.

The Recorder shall, as rapidly as his facilities permit, index and record such documents in his possession as affect the title to or possession of real property. The Recorder may preserve all documents, books, and records in the Recorder's possession by the process of photography or microphotography and these copies, when properly certified by the Recorder, shall be considered duplicate originals.
