§ 3806. Revision of Codes.

In revising the Commonwealth Code or in producing and revising a Commonwealth Administrative Code, the executive director may, with the approval of the commission:

- (a) Number and renumber chapters, sections and parts of sections;
- (b) Rearrange sections so that they fit harmoniously within the code;
- (c) Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered chapters, parts or sections;
- (d) Substitute the proper section or chapter number for the terms “the preceding section” or “this act” and similar terms;
- (e) Strike out figures where they are merely a repetition of written words;
- (f) Change capitalization for the purpose of conformity; and
- (g) Correct manifest clerical and typographical errors.
