TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS DIVISION 2: SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN, ETC.)

§ 2103. Slaughter Permit.

It shall be unlawful for any person(s) to slaughter cattle for local consumption or for export without first obtaining a slaughter permit from the resident director of Natural Resources for the island of Tinian. The permit cost for slaughtering for commercial consumption shall be \$10 per head, and permit cost for slaughtering for personal consumption shall be \$2.50 per head. The slaughter permit shall state the applicant's name, address, number and description of cattle, date of acquisition and type of weapon to be used. If the date of acquisition of the subject cattle is within the past six months, the source of acquisition shall also be indicated.
