DIVISION 2: SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN, ETC.)

§ 2523. Executive Director to Organize Work of Commission.

(a) The executive director shall be the chief administrative officer of the commission and, subject to the direction of the commission, shall organize the work of the commission in a manner that will ensure its efficient and effective operation.

(b) In the event of the illness or absence of the executive director and until a new executive director is appointed, it is competent for the deputy director to exercise the powers and functions and perform the duties of the executive director, and any such exercise or performance by the deputy director in a circumstance as aforesaid has the same force and effect as has such an exercise or performance by the executive director and shall be taken to be an exercise or performance by the executive director.

(c) In the event of the illness or absence of both the executive director and the deputy director, the exercise of the powers and functions of the executive director or the performance of his duties by the person who for the time being occupies or performs the duties of the office of the executive director has the same force and effect as has such an exercise or performance by the executive director and shall be taken to be an exercise or performance by the executive director.
