

TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS
DIVISION 2: SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN, ETC.)

§ 2564. Consideration of Application.

(a) Upon receipt of an application and compliance by the applicant with the provisions of the article in relation thereto, the executive director shall:

(1) Cause the photograph, fingerprints and palm prints of the applicant to be taken;

(2) Initiate and have followed through such investigatory procedures as he considers necessary in relation to the applicant and his application;

(3) Consider the application and materials and matters accompanying it together with the results of investigations made in connection therewith and make an assessment of:

(i) The integrity, responsibility, personal background and financial stability of the applicant;

(ii) The general reputation of the applicant, having regard to character, honesty and integrity; and

(iii) The suitability of the applicant to perform the type of work proposed to be performed by him as a licensee, after which he shall make a recommendation to the commission that the application be granted or that it be refused, provided, that the executive director may require the applicant to submit to him such additional information or material as he considers it necessary for him to have before making a recommendation or decision, as the case may be. Such information or material, upon receipt, shall be taken into consideration accordingly.

(b) In a case to which the proviso to 10 CMC § 2562(a)(9) is applicable, the executive director shall await the receipt of the supporting certificate within the required time before making a recommendation.
