**§ 2566. Notification of Employment and Display of Identification and Duration of License.**

(a) A casino operator shall notify the executive director in the prescribed form of the commencement of employment of a casino key employee or a casino employee within seven days of such commencement.

(b) A casino key employee or casino employee shall at all times while on duty in the casino wear a form of identification as prescribed on his person in such a manner as to be visible to other persons in the casino.

(c) Subsection (b) of this section is not applicable in the case of a person exempted by the executive director from the obligation to comply therewith. The executive director may so exempt a person or class of person from such obligation.

(d) A casino operator shall submit to the executive director once every six months a list of the licensees then employed in the casino. The list shall show in respect of each licensee:

- (1) His name and current address;
- (2) The type of license held by him;
- (3) The number of the license; and
- (4) Any other information prescribed.

(e) A casino key employee license or a casino employee license shall remain in force until:

- (1) The licensee dies;
- (2) It is canceled by the commission or surrendered by the licensee;
- (3) Licensee ceases to be employed in a casino in Tinian; or
- (4) The expiration of the term of the license as may be prescribed in 10 CMC § 2565(d).
