TITLE 2: NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION 4: LAND RESOURCES

§ 40104. Discrimination in Residential Real Estate-Related Transactions.

- (a) *In general*. It shall be unlawful for any person or other entity whose business includes engaging in residential real estate-related transactions to discriminate against any person in making available such a transaction, or in the terms or conditions of such a transaction, because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, marital status, or national origin.
- (b) *Definition*. As used in this section, the term "residential real estate-related transaction" means any of the following:
 - (1) The making or purchasing of loans or providing other financial assistance:
 - (i) For purchasing, constructing, improving, repairing, or maintaining a dwelling; or
 - (ii) Secured by residential real estate.
 - (2) The selling, brokering, or appraising of residential real property.
- (c) Appraisal exemption. Nothing in this chapter prohibits a person engaged in the business of furnishing appraisals of real property to take into consideration factors other than race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, familial status, or marital status.
