

TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES
DIVISION 1: EDUCATION

§ 1142. Transportation.

(a) The Public School System shall provide safe, adequate transportation to and from any public school for all entitled Commonwealth students who reside beyond a reasonable distance from the public school they attend. The Commissioner shall determine which Commonwealth students are entitled to transportation as well as what a “reasonable distance” means by regulation, provided further, that the regulation shall include an appeal process for those who are denied transportation eligibility.

(b) The Board shall adopt such policies, procedures, and programs as necessary to implement subsection (a).
