TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION 1: EDUCATION

§ 1142. Transportation.

- (a) The Public School System shall provide safe, adequate transportation to and from any public school for all entitled Commonwealth students who reside beyond a reasonable distance from the public school they attend. The Commissioner shall determine which Commonwealth students are entitled to transportation as well as what a "reasonable distance" means by regulation, provided further, that the regulation shall include an appeal process for those who are denied transportation eligibility.
- (b) The Board shall adopt such policies, procedures, and programs as necessary to implement subsection (a).
