

TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES
DIVISION 3: SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

§ 3102. Powers and Duties of Social Security Administrator: Generally.

The general administration and responsibility for the proper operation of this division shall be vested in the Social Security Administrator who shall have power to delegate duties and responsibilities to such employees as he or she deems feasible and desirable to carry out the provisions of this division. The Social Security Administrator may adopt, amend, or rescind regulations for the administration of this division subject to the approval of the Governor. The Social Security Administrator may hire employees as necessary within the limits of available funds budgeted for the administration of this division. The Social Security Administrator shall reimburse agencies of the United States government for expenses incurred in performing services in the administration of this division.
