**§ 2210. Determinations by the Commonwealth Ports Authority.**

Determinations of the scope of a concession per [4 CMC § 2201\(c\)](#), to grant a concession and enter into a concession agreement per [4 CMC § 2202\(a\)](#), to establish a certain concession fee per [4 CMC § 2202\(d\)](#), of the necessity for prepayment of the concession fee per [4 CMC § 2203](#), to award a new concession by bid or by request for proposal and to grant a concession or reject any or all bids or proposals per [4 CMC § 2206\(a\)](#), and to renew a concession per [4 CMC § 2206\(b\)](#) shall be made in writing by the Commonwealth Ports Authority explaining the reasoning for the determination. The Commonwealth Ports Authority shall establish, through appropriate rules and regulations, methods for providing adequate notice of determinations by the Commonwealth Ports Authority to potential or actual bidders or proposers acting pursuant to this chapter. Upon exhausting any appeals process of the Commonwealth Ports Authority established to review determinations made by it under this chapter, an aggrieved party may seek judicial review per [1 CMC § 9112](#).
