§ 4831. Annual Report for Registrar of Corporations.

(a) A limited liability company, and a foreign limited liability company authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth, shall deliver to the Registrar of Corporations for filing an annual report that sets forth:

(1) The name of the company and the state or country under whose law it is organized;

(2) The address of its designated office and the name and address of its agent for service of process in the Commonwealth;

(3) The address of its principal office; and

(4) The names and business addresses of any managers.

(b) Information in an annual report must be current as of the date the annual report is signed on behalf of the limited liability company.

(c) The first annual report and all succeeding annual reports must be delivered to the Registrar of Corporations in accordance with the provisions governing corporations in 4 CMC § 4693(c) of each year following the calendar year in which a limited liability company was organized.

(d) If an annual report does not contain the information required in subsection (a), the Registrar of Corporations shall promptly notify the reporting limited liability company or foreign limited liability company and return the report to it for correction. If the report is corrected to contain the information required in subsection (a) and delivered to the Registrar of Corporations within 30 days after the effective date of the notice, it is timely filed.
