§ 53030. Prohibition Against Smoking Marijuana in the Presence of Minors.

- (a) It is unlawful for any person to smoke marijuana in the presence of a person under 21 years of age, with exemptions applied to a medical marijuana patient.
- (b) A violation of subsection (a) is punishable by a fine of \$250 for the first offense, or \$1,000 for a second and subsequent offense.
