§ 3179. Declaration of Establishment as Non-Smoking.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, an owner, operator, manager, or other person in control of an establishment, facility, or outdoor area may declare that entire establishment, facility, or outdoor area as a nonsmoking place, including the outdoor area within 25 feet of the entrance or exit to such establishment. Smoking shall be prohibited in any place in which a sign conforming to the requirements of 6 CMC § 3180(a) is posted.
