§ 3324. Impersonating an Officer.

A person commits the offense of impersonating an officer if the person pretends to be an officer or falsely assumes or exercises the functions, duties, powers and privileges incident to being a police officer, corrections officer or firefighter either indirectly or directly to facilitate the commission of any crime.
