§ 6910. Governor's Warrant of Arrest: Assistance to Arresting Officer.

Every officer or other person empowered to make the arrest, as provided in 6 CMC § 6909, has the same authority in arresting the accused to command assistance therein as the Attorney General, Director of Public Safety, and other officers have by law in the execution of any criminal process directed to them, with like penalties against those who refuse their assistance.
