**DIVISION 1: DOMESTIC RELATIONS**

**§ 1722. Promise to Render Support.**

(a) Any promise in writing to furnish support for a child growing out of a supposed or alleged father and child relationship, does not require consideration and is enforceable according to its terms, subject to 8 CMC § 1706(d).

(b) In the best interest of child or mother, the court may, and upon the promisor's request shall, order the promise to be kept in confidence and designate a person or agency to receive and disburse on behalf of the child all amounts paid in performance of the promise.
