§ 19214. Subsequent Re-Issuance, Renewal or Other Extension of License.

After receipt of written confirmation of compliance from the Office, a licensing body shall, within five (5) working days, reissue, renew, or otherwise extend a license against which action had been taken for non-compliance with an order for support. The re-issuance, renewal, or other extension of the license after receipt of written confirmation of compliance shall occur pursuant to the requirements of the licensing body, except that the licensing body may waive any applicable requirement for re-issuance, renewal or other extension if it determines, in its sole discretion, that the imposition of that requirement places an undue burden on the non-custodial parent and that waiver of that requirement is consistent with the public interest.
