## TITLE 9: VEHICLE CODE DIVISION 2: REGISTRATION AND LICENSES

## § 2113. Registration of Right Hand Drive Vehicles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the owner of any right hand drive vehicle which entered the Commonwealth prior to the effective date of PL 11-12 shall be permitted to register the vehicle if it meets the safety and regulatory criteria set forth in 9 CMC § 2101(c).

**Commission Comment:** PL 11-54, § 1, that created this section came into effect on January 29, 1999.

PL 11-54 contained severability and savings clauses as follows:

Section 4. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

PL 11-12 came into effect on April 30, 1998. Section 2 of PL 11-12 created a new subsection (a)(8) of 6 CMC § 2301. Section 3 of PL 11-12 created new 6 CMC § 3111. Section 4 of PL 11-12 created new subsection (b) of 9 CMC § 1208. Section 5 of PL 11-12 created new 9 CMC § 2112.
