DIVISION 5: RULES OF THE ROAD

§ 5605. Parking Signs.

The director may, by regulation, place signs prohibiting or restricting the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway in the Commonwealth where such stopping, standing, or parking is dangerous to those using the highway or where the stopping, standing, or parking may unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic or the access of the public to limited parking near office or commercial buildings. The signs shall be official traffic signs and no person may stop, stand, or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on those signs.
