





AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$630,360 to provide for financial assistance to students of the Northern Mariana Islands.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1       Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of  
2       the General Fund of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands,  
3       the sum of \$630,360 which shall be used to provide financial  
4       assistance to eligible students in the Northern Mariana Islands,  
5       through scholarship boards in the islands of Saipan, Tinian and Rota  
6       as follows:

7	a) Saipan	\$490,824
8	b) Tinian	40,392
9	c) Rota	99,144

10       Section 2. Distribution of Funds. The funds appropriated by this  
11       Act shall be made available to the respective municipal scholarship  
12       boards in the amount allocated to the islands specified in Section 1  
13       above; PROVIDED, however, that fifty percent of the amount allocated  
14       to each scholarship board shall be reserved to cover financial needs  
15       of students for the first semester of school year 1979-1980.

16       Section 3. The municipal scholarship boards in the islands of  
17       Saipan, Tinian and Rota shall submit quarterly reports to the presiding  
18       officers of the Commonwealth Legislature on the expenditures of these  
19       funds and the specific allocations that have been made therefrom.

20       Section 4. The funds made available hereunder shall remain  
21       available until expended.

1           Section 5. The municipal scholarship boards in the islands of  
2   Saipan, Tinian and Rota shall continue to exist until otherwise  
3   provided by law.

4           Section 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the  
5   Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
