PUBLIC LAW NO. 6-16 SIXTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE H.B. NO. <u>6-45</u>, H.D.2, S.D.1 FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 1988

## AN ACT

To amend 1 CMC Section 3601 and 3602(c), to provide for the admission to practice before the Trial Court, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. 1 CMC Section 3601 is amended to read as
 follows:

3 "Section 3601. Admission to Practice. Persons Admitted to Practice Before the High Court of the Trust Territory of 4 the Pacific Islands on or before January 9, 1978; and any 5 person admitted to practice pursuant to 1 CMC Section 3603, 6 and who has actively practiced in the Commonwealth for two 7 consecutive years, and is an attorney licensed to practice in 8 any of the 50 states of the United States, its territories or 9 possessions, and who has engaged in the active practice of 10 law for at least five (5) of the last twelve years, shall be 11 entitled to admission to practice before the Commonwealth 12 Trial Court, and is entitled to receive a certificate of 13 admission to Practice law before the Commonwealth Trial 14 Court. The Court may impose a fee to cover the cost of 15 printing and issuing such certificates." 16

17 Section 2. 1 CMC Section 3602(c) is amended to read 18 as follows:

PUBLIC LAW NO. 6-16 House Bill No. <u>6-45, H.D.2</u>, S.D.1

"(c) Has graduated from a school accredited by the
American Bar Association or the American Association
of Law Schools or approved by the Commonwealth Trial
Court; and"
Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect
upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without
such approval.
