AN ACT

To amend the Northern Marianas Retirement Fund Act of 1988 by adding new subsections to 1 CMC §8323,8324, 8325 and 8326, to grant prior service credit for service rendered by employees of the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, Appellate Division; to grant prior service credit for service rendered by employees of the National Health Corp.; and to grant prior service credit for service rendered by employees of the Commission on Federal laws.

BE IT ENACTED RY THE EIGHTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH I LEGISLATURE:

Section I. Amendment. 1 CMC §8323 is amended as follows:

"(d) Service rendered to the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, Appellate Division from October 2, 1080 through May 1, 1989.

"(e) Service rendered to the National Health Corp., in the Northern Mariana Islands from September 1986 through September 1.990.

"(f) Service rendered to the Commission on Federal Laws in the Northern Mariana Islands from January 1981 through May 1 983.

Section 2. Amendment, 1 CMC §8324 (b) is amended as follows:

"(5) Thirteen percent (13%) of all salary received for services rendered to the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, Appellate Division from October 2, 1980 through May 1, 1989.

Section 4. Amendment. 1 CMC §8326 is amended as follows:

"(d) a percentage of each year's salary received for services rendered to the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, Appellate Division from October 2, 1980 through May 1, 1 989, whereby the percentage to be paid shall be the sum of the member contributions required by Section 8361 and the government contributions required by Section 8362.

"(e) a percentage of each year's salary received for services rendered to the National Health Corp., from September 1986 through September 1990, whereby **the** percentage to be paid shall be the sum of the member contributions required by Section 8361 and the government contributions required by Section 8362.

"(f) a percentage of each year's salary received for services rendered to the Commission on Federal Laws from January 1981 through May 1983, whereby the percentage to be paid shall be the sum of the member contributions required by Section 83 6 I. and the government contributions required by Section 8362.

19Section 5. Severability. If any Section of this Act is held invalid by a court20of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon irs becoming law without such approval.
