AN ACT

To re-program fund balance from Public Law No. 8-2; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NINTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to re-program fund balance funds from Public Law No. 8-2 for the construction and renovation of the existing toilet facilities at Oleai Elementary School.

Section 2. Re-programming. There is hereby re-programmed \$70,189.61 from Public Law No. 8-2, Section 410, Subsection b, 1, 2, and 3, Public School System lumpsum payment for accrued annual leave (\$66,471.77), reimbursement from typhoon related expenditure (\$3,517.84) and school vans and buses (\$200,00), to construct and renovate the existing Oleai Elementary School toilet facilities. The Commissioner of Education shall be the expenditure authority.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
