AN ACT

To repeal and re-enact 6 CMC § 4204 setting the compensation for members of the Board of Parole; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ELEVENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Act is to compensate members of the Board of Parole who actually attend meetings of the Board as prescribed by law or Board regulations.

Section 2. <u>Repeal and Re-enactment</u>. The provisions of 6 CMC § 4204 are hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"§ 4204. <u>Board of Parole: Compensation</u>. Members of the Board shall be compensated in accordance with 1 CMC § 8247."

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective. Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
