PUBLIC LAW NO. 12-35 H. B. NO. 12-202, SD1, HD1

AN ACT

To re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-24 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TWELFTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this bill is to re-appropriate fund balances from Public Law 9-24 as appropriated for the construction of Chalan Kiya waterline and the Design and Construction of Oleai waterline replacement.

Section 2. <u>Re-appropriation</u>. There is hereby re-appropriated \$40,500 from the construction of Chalan Kiya waterline and \$1,445 from the Design and Construction of Oleai waterline replacement, the total unexpended fund balance of \$41,945 for the purpose of constructing outdoor stage at Oleai Elementary School.

The Secretary of Public Works shall be the expenditure authority, funds shall be available without fiscal year limitation.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any Section of this Act should be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

PUBLIC LAW NO. 12-35 HOUSE BILL NO. 12-202, SD1, HD1

Section 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon it becoming law without such approval.
