PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-104 H. B. No. 15-317, **HDI**

AN ACT

To Appropriate \$800,000.00 EARNED UNDER THE \$60 MILLION CIP BOND (PUBLIC LAW 11-102) FOR THE ROTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIFTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds that Rota is in dire need of 2 assistance to stimulate its tourism industry. The Legislature also finds that the 3 Commonwealth Ports Authority is in negotiations with major carriers to bring international 4 charter flights direct to Rota. Although some carriers have expressed interest in flying direct 5 charter flights to Rota, the Rota International Airport facility is not properly equipped to 6 handle jet aircraft. Aside from the ground and other equipment that the servicing of jet 7 aircraft would require, the airport itself would need to be renovated to accommodate the 8 larger passenger and cargo capacity anticipated on such charter flights. The purpose of this 9 act is to appropriate \$800,000.00 earned under the \$60 million CIP Bonds (Public Law 10 11-102) administered by the Commonwealth Development Authority.

Section 2. <u>Appropriation.</u> Notwithstanding any provision of law, there is hereby
 appropriated \$800,000.00, earned under the \$60 million CIP Bond as authorized by Public
 Law 11-102, for the Rota International Airport to fund:

14a. the purchase of collateral equipment necessary to service jet aircraft at the15airport terminal;

b. renovations and installation of fixtures at the airport terminal building and
wherever necessary, including but not limited to, arrival, departure and cargo areas, to
handle the passenger capacity of commercial jet aircraft capable of international
flights to Rota; and

PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-104 HOUSE BILL No. 15-317, HDI

1 Section 3. <u>Expenditure Authority.</u> The Chairman of the Board of the 2 Commonwealth Ports Authority shall be the expenditure authority of funds appropriated in 3 section 2 of this Act. The funds shall not lapse, not be subject to any fiscal year limitation, 4 nor be reprogranuned for any other purpose.

S Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

9 Section 5. <u>Savings Clause</u>. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be 10 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes 11 repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers 12 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. 13 The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, 14 any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act 15 becomes effective.

Section 6. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
 Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
