## AN ACT

To appropriate $\$ 367,000.00$ from the Third Senatorial District Developers Infrastructure Tax Fund collection; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SIXTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE: provision of law, the amount of $\$ 367,000.00$ from the Developers Infrastructure Tax Fund collection for the Third Senatorial District is hereby appropriated as follows:
(a) $\$ 86,000.00$ to pave the student parking area at Kagman High School and the parking areas of staff and faculty at KoblerviIIe Elementary School under the expenditure of the Secretary of the Department of Public Works in consultation with the affected school principals.
(b) $\$ 15,000.00$ for the rehabilitation of the Kagman II baseball field and the expenditure authority is the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.
(c) $\$ 10,000.00$ for the improvement and upkeep of the Veteran Cemetery at Marpi under the expenditure authority of the Executive Director of the Veterans Affairs.
(d) $\$ 107,000.00$ for the paving and drainage improvement of the Tangantangan Road under the expenditure authority of the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.
(e) $\$ 104,000.00$ to upgrade the water lines in Dandan and the expenditure authority is the Executive Director of the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation.
(f) $\$ 45,000.00$ to pave the coral road at Northern Marians College under the expenditure authority of the President of the Northern Marianas College.

Section 2. Reprogramming and Fiscal Year Limitation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the funds allotted for capital improvement projects under this Act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitation. Additionally, funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

Section 3. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repeaters contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
