SENATE BILL NO. 16-44, CS1, HD2

AN ACT

TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 14-62; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SIXTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Findings and Purposes. The Commonwealth Legislature herby finds 2 that due to the difficulty of recruiting physicians to serve in the Commonwealth hospital and 3 clinics, patients' access to health care is greatly diminished. Because of the extensive 4 training that nurse practitioners must undergo in order to be licensed in the United States and 5. the Commonwealth, the increasing use of nurse practitioners as alternative health care 6 providers in many rural areas on the United States, and the availability of professionally 7 trained and educated local nurse practitioners who can provide quality healthcare services. 8 increasing nurse practitioners' autonomy will improve access to quality health care in the 9 Commonwealth. The Legislature finds and declares that this Act is necessary and a proper 10 use of the legislative power granted by Article II of the Commonwealth Constitution.

11 Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. Section 2304(a) of Public Law 14-62 is amended as 12 follows:

"(a) "Advanced Practice Registered Nurse" means a nurse in the practice of
 Advanced Practice Registered Nursing by Certified Nurse Practitioners, Certified
 Registered Nurse Anesthetists, Certified Nurse Midwives, and Clinical Nurse

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1	dispensing therapeutic measures appropriate to the Advanced Practice Registered
2	Nurse's area of specialty as defined by the Board; and
3	(9) Recognizing limits of knowledge and experience, planning for situations beyond
4	expertise, and consulting with or referring clients to other health care providers as
5	appropriate."
6	Section 3. <u>Amendment</u> . Section 2304(k) of Public Law 14-62 is amended as
7	follows:
8	"(k) "Prescriptive/Dispensing Authority" means an Advanced Practice
9	Registered Nurse authorized to prescribe and dispense drugs and therapeutic
10	measures described within scope of practice, defined by the board, and described in
11	the Written Agreement entered into with the supervising physician. The
12	authorization to prescribe and dispense drugs and therapeutic measures is for
13	administration to and use by other persons (patients or clients) within the scope of
14	practice of the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse.
15	Section 4. <u>Amendment</u> . Section 2305(b) of Public Law 14-62 is amended as
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1	"(a) Be responsible for enforcing the provisions of this chapter. The Board shall have
2	all of the duties, powers and authority specifically granted by and necessary to the
3	enforcement of this chapter, including subpoena power, the ability to promulgate rules and
4	regulations necessary to implement the intent of the Nurse Practice Act, as well as such
5	other duties, powers and authority as it may be granted by law appropriate status."
6	Section 6. Amendment. Section 2306(e) (13) of Public Law 14-62 is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	"(13) Maintain membership in national organizations to include but not
9	limited to the National Council of State Boards of Nursing that develop and regulate
10	the national nursing licensure examinations and exclusively promote the
11	improvement of the legal standards of the practice of nursing for the protection of the
12	public health, safety and welfare, and follow nationally recognized guidelines for
13	oversight of nurses and advance practice registered nurses."
14	Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
15	provision to any person or circumstances should be held invalid by a court of competent
16	jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
17	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.
18	Section 8. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
19	construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
20	repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
21	contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior
22	law. The enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way

modifying, any liability (civil or criminal), which shall already be in existence at the date
 this Act becomes effective.
 Section 9. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the

4 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
