H. B. 17-167

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE NINETEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$19,124.00) FROM THE SAIPAN TRUST FUND TO ASSIST IN THE PRESERVATION OF ARTIFACTS AND OPERATIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH **MUSEUM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

The Bill was not referred to a House Committee.

THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON FIRST AND FINAL, MARCH 28, 2011;

with amendments in the form of H. B. 17-167, HD1 and transmitted to the THE SENATE.

The Bill was not referred to a Senate Committee. THE BILL WAS PASSED BY THE SENATE ON FIRST AND FINAL READING, APRIL 29, 2011: without amendments.

H. B. 17-167, HD1 WAS RETURNED TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON MAY 3, 2011.

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE NINETEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FOUR DOLLARS (19,124.00) FROM THE SAIPAN TRUST FUND TO ASSIST IN THE PRESERVATION OF ARTIFACTS AND OPERATIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH MUSEUM.

Be it enacted by the Seventeenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Short Title. This Act shall be cited as the "Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Museum Preservation and Operations Update Act of 2011."

Section 2. <u>Findings</u>. The Commonwealth Legislature finds that the Commonwealth Museum is in possession of historical artifacts linked to the ancestors of the Chamorro and Carolinian people of the Commonwealth. The Legislature further finds that the preservation of many of the artifacts in the museum are at risk due to the damages caused by flooding from water run-offs during the monsoon season of the CNMI.

The Legislature also finds that due to budgetary constraints, the Commonwealth Museum has vacated their rental storage facility, and is in need of materials to secure the multitude of historic artifacts, until such time as a permanent facility is constructed. The Legislature finds that there is a significant collection of artifacts originally from Tinian, that are subject to a consent decree governing their care and subject to an annual care and condition assessment, as well as other historic collections whose care is governed by contractual requirements, and memorandums of agreement.

Additionally, the Legislature finds that many of the Commonwealth's visitors (tourist) frequent the Commonwealth Museum as part of their package tour to learn a little about the history of the people of the Northern Mariana Islands. The Legislature finds that the tourism industry is the sole surviving industry in this ailing economy and that more funds should be invested to attract our visitors to visit the beautiful islands we call home. Therefore it is the purpose of this Act to appropriate the sum of Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Twenty Four Dollars (\$19,124.00) from the Saipan Trust Fund for the Preservation of artifacts and operational costs of the Commonwealth Museum.

Section 3. <u>Appropriation</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated from the Saipan Trust Fund, the amount of Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Twenty Four Dollars (\$19,124.00) for Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Museum.

Section 4. Expenditure Authority. The Executive Director of the CNMI Museum of History and Culture in concurrence of the Chairperson of the Museum Board shall be the expenditure authority of funds appropriated herein.

Section 5. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.
