AN ACT

TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATIONS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

Section 1. Short title. This Act shall be cited as the "Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2014."

Section 2. <u>Findings and purpose</u>. The Legislature finds that the Honorable Eloy S. Inos, Governor of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands has identified an additional \$12,386,000.00 from the following programs:

1.	Gross revenue tax conection (prior years)	\$7,424,000.0
2.	Wage and Salary Tax (prior years)	\$700,000.00
3.	Personal Income Tax (prior years)	\$371,724.00

9	The Legislature further finds that this sum has been approved by the Legislature as available	
10	for appropriation in Fiscal Year 2014 by House Concurrent Resolution 18-3. The Purpose of	
11	this Act is to appropriate these funds for the operation and activities of the Commonwealth	
12	Government as specified herein.	
13	Section 3. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to	
14	the contrary the amount of \$12,386,000.00 as identified as additional resources by Honorable	
15	Eloy S. Inos, Governor of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands in his	
16	May 21, 2014 letter to the Legislature is appropriated as follows:	
17	1. The sum of \$5,000,000.00 to meet the payment requirement to the Settlement	
18	Fund.	
19	2. The sum of \$7,326,000.00 for the payment of the employer share of the Group	
20	Health and Life Insurance Premiums for Retirees (EER).	
21	3. The sum of \$60,000.00 to the Election Commission for operational and personnel	

cost associated with the office.

HOUSE BILL 18-192, HD1

Section 4. Reprogramming. Funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed or spent for any purpose other than those for which they are appropriated, shall remain available until fully expended without fiscal year limitation and shall not be subject to continuing resolution.

Section 5. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

House Bill 18-192, HD1

Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or its becoming law without such approval.
