**ORDER REVOKING
PROBATION AS TO
DEFENDANT
NEILDINO TAISACAN**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on March 16, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom 223A of the Guma Hustisia Building, pursuant to the Government’s Notice of Revocation of Defendant’s Probation in this matter. The Government was represented by Assistant Attorney General, Grant D. Sanders. Defendant Neildino Taisacan appeared with Counsel, John Osborn, Esq.

At the hearing undisputed evidence was presented that showed that Defendant was sentenced in October 1999 to ten (10) years in jail all suspended except for one (1) year, along with the other miscellaneous terms and conditions. The sentence was for conviction of the crime of Kidnapping. Defendant was also convicted in Criminal Case No.00-0523 of the crimes of Assault & Battery (2 Counts) and Disturbing the Peace (1 Count). He was sentenced to a total

1 of two (2) years imprisonment therefor and is presently serving his sentence.

2 After reviewing the evidence and hearing the arguments of counsel, the Court for good
3 cause, revokes the probation of Defendant in Criminal Case No. 97-0049 and pursuant to 6 CMC
4 § 4105 orders that three (3) years of the suspended sentence be hereby re-imposed to be served
5 consecutively to Defendant's present sentence.
