## ADOPTED RULES & REGULATIONS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PAROLE APPLICATION FOR PAROLE

The Secretary, Board of Parole, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands on behalf of the Chairperson and in accordance with Public Law 1-8, Title I, Chapter 8, Sections 5 and 6, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and other applicable Laws in the Commonwealth, wishes to advise the general public of the adoption of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Parole, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

The Adopted Rules and Regulations include the following subjects: The duties of the Board of Parole regarding promulgation of Rules and Regulations, Assistance to courts, establishing eligibility criteria for parole, parole hearings, conditions of parole, supervision of parolees, revocation of parole and discharge. The Adopted Eligibility Criteria for Parole includes the following subjects: incarceration, parole or probation status, criminal status, prohibitions, appearances, acceptances and agreements.

# BOARD OF PAROLE

WHEREAS, Public Law 1-8, Title I, Chapter 8, Sections 5 and 6, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands authorizes the Board of Parole to adopt rules and regulations with respect to eligibility criteria for parole, the conduct of parole hearings and conditions to be imposed upon parolees and with respect to revocation of paroles by the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE FOREGOING, the Board of Parole of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands does hereby adopt the following rules entitled "Rules and Regulations", in implementation of Public Law 1-8, Title I, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands:

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## Board of Parole

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

Section I

- It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to promulgate Rules and Regulations for the operation of the Board of Parole.
- It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to, if requested, to assist the Courts of the Commonwealth, as regards to the supervision of persons placed on probation.
- 3. It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to establish eligibility criteria for parole.
- It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to conduct parole hearings.
- 5. It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to establish reasonable conditions of parole.
- It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to establish rules and regulations regarding supervision of persons placed on parole.
- 7. It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to revoke parole for violation of the conditions of parole.
- 8. It shall be the duty of the Board of Parole to enter a final order of discharge when a parolee has performed the conditions of parole.

Section II.

The ancillary duties of the Board of Parole are as follows: to do everything proper, necessary, advisable or convenient for the duties hereinabove set forth and to do all other things incidental to them or connected with them that are not forbidden by law, or by these rules and regulations.

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## Board of Parole

#### Eligibility Criteria For Parole.

Pursuant to the Board of Parole Rules and Regulations (enacted January 30, 1979), Section I, 3., the Board of Parole establishes the following criteria for admission to Parole.

Parole is a privilege, not a right.

- 1. All convicted persons are eligible for the privilege of parole if they meet the following criteria:
  - a. Have been convicted of a crime, finally sentenced and serving a term of imprisonment;
  - b. Are not under parole or probation of this or any other jurisdiction;
  - c. Have no pending criminal charges in this or any other jurisdiction;
  - d. There are not any applicable laws prohibiting the convicted person from being granted the privilege of parole;
  - e. The person must make a formal application for parole to the Board of Parole;
  - f. The person must personally appear at a hearing before the Board of Parole and present evidence to the members present, limited to, why the applicant should be granted the privilege of parole. Written documents can be submitted, for consideration, at any time after the submission of the Application For Parole and up to ten (10) days prior to the final decision of the Board of Parole.
  - g. The person must accept and agree to any and all terms and conditions of parole.
  - h. The person must accept and agree that parole can be revoked for violating any of the terms and conditions of parole at any time by the Board of Parole or its delegates, and is automatically revoked upon arrest, subject to a hearing before the Board of Parole as to why the revocation should not be made permanent.
