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NOTICE OF EMERGENCY AND ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

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Emergency: The Department of Public Health and Environmental Services finds that pursuant to Title 1 CMC Division 2, Chapter 12, section 2605(n), and Title 3 CMC Division 2, Chapter 1, section 2131, that the public interest requires the adoption, on an emergency bases, of Rules and Regulations allowing for the quarantine of individuals with communicable diseases who are unwilling to submit to necessary treatment. The Department of Public Health and Environmental Services further finds that the public interest requires that the Rules and Regulations become effective immediately upon concurrence of the Governor and filing with the Registrar of Corporations; and shall remain effective for a period of 120 days, as more fully hereinafter set forth.

Reason For Emergency: The public interest requires adoption of these Rules and Regulations prior to the publication of the next edition of the Commonwealth Register due to the fact that there is an imminent threat to the public health because of a recent outbreak of highly contagious tuberculosis. Some individuals infected with this disease have been unwilling to submit to treatment which is necessary to contain the disease to keep it from spreading. These individuals must be quarantined immediately to prevent the spread of the communicable disease to the general public.

Prior Publication and Public Comment: These Rules and Regulations Governing Communicable Disease were published for comment in Volume 13, Number 9 of the Commonwealth Register on September 15, 1991. The Department of Public Health & Environmental Services did not receive any public comments throughout the thirty day waiting period. The Rules and Regulations are therefore being adopted in their original form, and final certification of the Rules and Regulations will be published in the November 15, 1993 Commonwealth Register.

<u>Authority</u>: The Department of Public Health and Environmental Services is authorized to promulgate these regulations pursuant to 1 CMC §2605(n) and 3 CMC §2131.

NOTICE OF EMERGENCY AND ADOPTION OF PROPOSED PERSONNEL REGULATIONS

EMERGENCY: The Civil Service Commission finds for the reasons given and pursuant to Title 1, CMC, Division 9, Chapter 1, Section 9104 (b) that the public interest requires the adoption of emergency regulations, upon the concurrence of the Governor, to create regulations by which to administer the new Sick Leave Bank, newly created by the Legislature through Public Law-25. The Commission also finds that the public interest requires that these regulations shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Registrar of Corporations for the reasons given and shall remain effective for 120 days.

REASON FOR EMERGENCY: The public interest requires adoption of these regulations upon fewer than 30 days notice. The Legislature has just created a Sick Leave Bank, through the passage of Public Law 8-25, and directed the Civil Service Commission to administer it. The Commission has already received requests from government employees to use the Sick Leave Bank. Since there are presently no rules and regulations in existence, and the Commission requires regulations with which to fairly and properly administer the Sick Leave Bank, emergency adoption of such regulations is necessary.

CONTENTS: The regulations provide a procedure by which the Sick Leave Bank shall be operated, to ensure fairness and avoid abuses. The emergency regulations are published following this notice.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: It is the intent of the Civil Service Commission to also adopt these regulations as permanent, pursuant to Title 1, CMC, Division 9 Section 9104 (a) (1) and (2), therefore publication in the Commonwealth Register, notice, opportunity for comment and, if necessary, hearing will be provided. Comments on the contents of these regulations may be sent to: Chairman, Civil Service Commission, P.O. Box 5150, Saipan, MP 96950.

AUTHORITY: The Civil Service Commission is authorized to promulgate regulations pursuant to Title 1, CMC, Division 9, Chapter 1; Title 1, CMC, Division 8, Section 8117; and Public Law 8-25.

NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS RETIREMENT FUND Adopted Amendment To The Fund's Administrative Rules And Regulations

The Board of Trustees for the Northern Mariana Islands Retirement Fund hereby promulgate these rules and regulations pursuant to Public Law 6-17, 1 CMC 8316 (f) of the Northern Mariana Islands Retirement Fund Act of 1988, and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1 CMC 9101, et. seq.

PART I. AUTHORITY.

Under and by virtue of the provisions of 1 CMC 8316, the Board of Trustees for the Northern Mariana Islands Retirement Fund hereby promulgate these rules and regulations.

PART II. PURPOSE.

To repeal and re-promulgate Section 3.5, Prior Service for Class II Members, to provide for an open period to allow Class II members to elect to be credited for prior service.

PART III. AMENDMENTS.

3.5. Prior Service for Class II Members.

- (a) Class II members who have prior service and who have not elected to receive such credit must elect within 90 days of the effective date of these regulations to be eligible for such prior service credit; provided, however, that the required contributions are paid for services beginning October 1, 1980, and thereafter, as herein provided. Failure to apply to be credited for such prior service shall be deemed an irrevocable rejection of the credits.
- (b) Payment for prior service credit shall be paid by lump sum or installment through payroll deduction over a period not to exceed seven (7) years from the date such election is made. If a member retires prior to the full payment of the prior service, the same level of payment shall be automatically deducted from the pension of the member. If the member dies leaving an eligible surviving beneficiary(ies), the benefit of the surviving beneficiary(ies) shall be reduced in allocable proportion to meet fifty percent (50%) of the total benefits until the prior service liability is fully satisfied.

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- (c) All payments for prior service credit shall include regular interest from the date the salary was first paid to the employee until the debt is fully paid. The principal amount due shall consist of the employee contribution rate at the time the salary or wages were paid and the regular interest computed at the time of election. Payment on installment will continue to accrue regular interest on the principal until it is fully paid.
- (d) Only employees as of the effective date of these regulations and those who retired on or after May 7, 1989 and terminated vested Class II members who are hired thereafter may elect to receive prior service credit.
- (e) For purposes of this Section, prior service includes services lost through refunding of contributions.
