

# NOTICE OF EMERGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE LIMITED IMMUNITY FOR ILLEGAL ALIENS LAW AND NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT PERMANENT REGULATIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ALIEN LABOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

**EMERGENCY:** The Secretary of Labor and Immigration must promulgate rules and regulations to implement the limited immunity for illegal aliens law recently passed by the Legislature. The Secretary finds that the public interest requires adoption of these regulations immediately upon the concurrence of the Governor. Once approved, the Emergency Regulations shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed 120 days as set forth in 1 CMC Section 9104 (b).

**REASON FOR THE EMERGENCY:** The passage of Public Law 11 - 33 require immediate promulgation of rules and regulations to establish a procedure through which illegal aliens may claim the limited immunity and to educate the public about this new procedure.

**CONTENTS:** The rules and regulations provide the procedures for illegal aliens to claim the limited immunity granted to them under Public Law 11 - 33. The rules and regulations also reiterate the effective dates and eligibility requirements and define selected terms.

**INTENT TO ADOPT**: The Secretary intends to adopt these regulations and amendments to existing regulations as permanent regulations pursuant to 1 CMC Section 9104(a)(1) and (2), and therefore publishes in the Commonwealth Register this notice of opportunity to submit comments. If necessary, a hearing will be provided. Copies on the content of the regulations may be sent to: Secretary, Department of Labor and Immigration, Caller Box 10007, Capitol Hill, Saipan, MP 96950.

<u>AUTHORITY</u>: The Secretary is authorized to promulgate these regulations pursuant to Section 8 of Public Law 11 - 33.

#### **REGULATIONS**

#### 1. Effective Dates

The effective date for Public Law 11 - 33 is December 2, 1998. It remains in effect for six (6) months or through and including June 1, 1999. All illegal aliens who wish to apply for the limited immunity must register with the Department of Labor and Immigration (hereinafter "the Department") by the close of business on June 1, 1999.

Anyone who registers by the close of business on June 1, 1999 will be given 90 days during which he or she may seek temporary work. By the 90th day after registration, the alien must have secured a temporary employer. Within ninety (90) days after the issuance of the limited immunity temporary work authorization (see 3 (C) below) an application for a one year contract for employment must be submitted on behalf of the alien pursuant to the usual procedures under the Non-resident Workers Act, 3 CMC Section 4411 et. seq.

#### 2. Eligibility Requirements

A. A qualified illegal alien is one who entered the CNMI on or before January 1, 1998. The alien may have entered as a non-resident worker, a tourist, a student, a missionary, or a short or long term business permit holder, or any other entry category. In order for an illegal alien to become a legal alien, an application for a one year contract for employment must be submitted on behalf of the alien pursuant to the usual procedures under the Non-resident Workers Act, 3 CMC Section 4411 et. seq., within 90 days from the date of issuance of the limited immunity temporary work authorization.

#### B. The following are **ineligible** for the grant of limited immunity:

- (1) Any alien who entered the CNMI after January 1, 1998 or whose contract was renewed after January 1, 1998.
- (2) Any alien convicted of a felony or two or more misdemeanors or of a crime involving moral turpitude.
- (3) Any alien who has been ordered by the Superior Court deported from the CNMI.
- (4) Any alien who is the subject of a Bench Warrant issued as a result of the alien's failure to appear in a deportation proceeding.
- (5) Any alien who has already been served with an Order To Show Cause as to why he or she should not be deported and whose deportation proceeding is still pending.

#### 3. The Procedure

- A. In order to register for the limited immunity, an illegal alien must present him or herself to the Department between and including the dates of December 2, 1998 and June 1, 1999. He or she does not need a passport in order to register for the limited immunity program.
- B. Upon presentation at the Department, the alien will be asked to complete a form providing background information (the Limited Immunity Registration Form or Limited Immunity Form No. 1). Upon completion of this form, the alien will be provided a letter authorizing him or her to seek a temporary employer (Limited Immunity Authorization to Seek a Temporary Employer Form or Limited Immunity Form No. 2). The Authorization to Seek a Temporary Employer will be valid for ninety (90) days from the date of registration at the Department.
- C. Once the alien obtains a temporary employer, the alien and his or her potential employer shall report to the Department to fill out the limited immunity temporary work authorization (LITWA or Limited Immunity Form No. 3). The LITWA is valid for ninety (90) days from its date of issuance. The fee for the LITWA is \$ 100; the fee is designated for use by the Deportation Fund and will be used to repatriate applicants for the immunity for whom no one year work permit is issued (i.e., because either no application was submitted or because the application was denied for a valid reason.)
- D. The TWA employer must submit an application for a one year work permit under the usual application procedures pursuant to the Non-resident Workers Act, 3 CMC Section 4411 et. seq., within 90 days from the date of issuance of the LITWA. The alien need not have a valid passport in order for the application to be submitted; however, before the one year permit is issued, the alien must produce a valid passport.
- E. A health screening is required in accordance with the Department of Public Health regulations, Vol. 20, No. 6, Commonwealth Register (June 15, 1998). The employer is responsible, as usual, for the costs of the health screening, the health certificate, and the one year work permit application processing fees. Requiring the employee to pay any of these costs is a violation of the law and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- F. The temporary employer is responsible for any medical expenses incurred by the employee. The employer must also produce, as usual, a valid bond from the list of bonding companies approved by the Director of Labor.
- G. If an alien who registers for the limited immunity fails to secure an employer and / or fails to have an application for a one year permit submitted on his or her behalf within the requisite 90 days, then that individual will be repatriated pursuant to Public Laws 10 1 and 11 5.

The Department of Finance proposes to promulgate regulations pursuant to 1 CMC section 2553, 1 CMC section 2557, Sections 3 and 5 of Saipan Local Law 11-1, and the Commonwealth Administrative Procedures Act, 1 CMC section 9101 et. seq., and other applicable Commonwealth Law.

These rules and regulations are promulgated to assist in the implementation of the Viewers Tax Act, Saipan Local Law 11-1, delegated to the Department of Finance to enforce.

Provides guidelines and procedures needed for compliance with the Viewers Tax Act, Saipan Local Law No. 11-1. It provides the requirements for filing returns and making payment of the Viewers Tax, and sets forth other administrative procedures.

The Secretary of Finance, hereby proposes to promulgate regulations for the implementation of the Viewers Tax Act, Saipan Local Law No. 11-1. The proposed Viewers Tax Regulations No. TSD-98001 is promulgated by virtue of the authority and direction set forth in the Commonwealth Code including, but not limited to, 1 CMC §2553, 1 CMC §2557, §§ 3 and 5 of Saipan Local Law No. 11-1, and the Commonwealth Administrative Procedure Act, 1 CMC §9101 et. seq.

The proposed Viewers Tax Regulations No. TSD-98001 provides for the manner in which persons in the business of renting video tapes and in the business of providing viewing of motion or animated pictures are to file returns and pay taxes.

#### PROPOSED REGULATIONS NO. TSD-98001

#### Section 1. General Provision.

Section 1.1. <u>Authority</u>. The authority for the promulgation and issuance of the Department of Finance Regulations No. TSD-98001 is by virtue of the authority and directions set forth in 1 CMC §\$2553, 2557, the Commonwealth Administrative Procedures Act, 1 CMC §9101 et. seq., and Saipan Local Law No. 11-1, the Viewers Tax Act of 1998.

Section 1.2. <u>Purpose and Scope</u>. The purpose of these Regulations is to establish the policy and procedures to implement and provide uniform enforcement of the Viewers Tax Act of 1998 delegated to the Department of Finance for implementation.

#### Section 2. Tax Imposed.

Section 2.1. <u>Persons Subject to Tax</u>. There is hereby imposed on every person engaged in the Third Senatorial District in the business of renting video tapes, and/or selling admission tickets for viewing of a motion or animated picture for which an entry fee is charged, a tax of fifteen (15) cents for every video tape rented, and for every admission ticket sold.

#### Section 3. Compliance Requirement.

Section 3.1. <u>Declaration of Tax</u>. Every person subject to tax under Section 3 shall make a report and pay the tax to the Secretary of Finance in the manner prescribed in these Regulations, setting forth the number of video tapes rented and the number of admission tickets sold.

Section 3.2. Reporting and Payment Requirements. Every person subject to subsection 2.1 of these Regulations is required to file a quarterly return and pay the tax thereon. For purposes of this subsection, quarterly returns are due no later than one month after the end of each calendar quarter, to wit: first calendar quarter for the period January 1 to March 31, is due April 30; second calendar quarter for the period April 1 to June 30, is due July 31; third calendar quarter for the period July 1 to September 30, is due October 31; fourth calendar quarter for the period October 1 to December 31, is due January 31 of the next calendar year.

Section 3.3. <u>Place for Filing and Payment of Tax</u>. On or before the due date set forth in section 3.2 of these Regulations, every person subject to tax shall file a quarterly return and pay the tax at the Department of Finance, Division of Revenue and Taxation.

Section 3.4. <u>Tax Forms</u>; <u>Signatures</u>. The Secretary of Finance shall prescribe the tax form for reporting purposes of these Regulations, and require any information that is deemed necessary and appropriate to carry out the intent of the Viewers Tax Act of 1998. All returns submitted as required by these Regulations must be signed by a natural person, under penalty of perjury. No return shall be complete until it is signed by the taxpayer. In the case of a corporation, the return shall be signed by the president, vice-president, treasurer, assistant treasurer, chief accounting officer or any other officer duly authorized to act on behalf of the corporation.

Section 3.5. Form of Payment. Payment of this tax must be paid in cash, U.S. Postal Money Order, or check drawn at a bank in the Northern Mariana Islands, or a bank in any of the states in the United States of America made payable to the "CNMI Treasurer". The Department of Finance shall have the right to reject any or all personal checks and demand payment in the form of cash, U.S. Postal Money Order, or certified check.

Section 3.6. Record Maintenance. A full and accurate record of all business transactions necessary to determine the tax imposed under the Viewers Tax Act of 1998, must be maintained for a minimum of six (6) years and shall be made available for inspection upon request by the Secretary of Finance.

**Section 4. Severability**. If any provision of these Regulations shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the validity of the remainder of the Regulations shall not be affected thereby.
