PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Citation of Statutory Authority:

1 CMC §2605 states that "the Department of Public Health ... shall adopt rules and regulations regarding those matters over which it has jurisdiction, including but not limited to regulations deemed necessary to the public health and safety respecting: (j) Hospitals, clinics ..." 1 CMC §2603(f) grants the Department of Public Health the power and duty to administer all government-owned health care facilities.

Short Statement of Goals & Objectives:

The Department of Public Health must revise its fee schedule from time to time in order to reflect the actual cost of providing health services, or to add fees for services that become available as a result of new equipment acquisitions or the addition of medical personnel in a particular specialty area.

Brief Summary of the Proposed Rule:

To establish fees for services provided at the various health care facilities operated by the Department of Public Health, including the Commonwealth Health Center, the Tinian Health Center, the Rota Health Center, the Division of Public Health, and the San Antonio Clinic.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Title 1 CMC Division 2, Chapter 12, and in particular 1 CMC §2603(f) and 2605(j), provides that the Secretary of the Department of Public Health (DPH) shall administer all government owned facilities and shall implement rules and regulations for the efficient delivery of health services in the CNMI.

Pursuant to this authority, the Secretary is amending specific fees from the Schedule of Medical and Other Related Fees which was published in its entirety, and adopted, in the Commonwealth Register Volume 17, Number 2, dated February 15, 1995 and Volume 17, Number 4, dated April 15, 1995, respectively. RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE INVESTIGATION OF DEATHS AND THE PERFORMANCE OF AUTOPSIES IN THE CNMI

As provided in 1 CMC §2633, the Secretary of Health and the Attorney General may recommend that an autopsy be performed on a deceased individual. To avoid further uncertainty and confusion as to when autopsies will be requested, set forth below is a listing of those deaths that would warrant the performance of an autopsy under the authority of the Department of Public Health or the Office of the Attorney General. These regulations shall not apply to autopsies requested by the family of the deceased.

- (a) Violent, unusual, or unnatural deaths, including but not limited to, any death attributed to: accident, other than a motor vehicle accident; suicide; homicide; or poisoning; xx
- (b) Deaths attributed to physical, electrical, chemical, radiation, thermal, or related means;
- (c) All deaths occurring under suspicious or unusual circumstances;
- (d) Sudden deaths without obvious cause when the individual was previously in apparent health;
- (e) Deaths occurring as a result of an illness without clear etiology but with suspicion of being contagious or communicable to the public; **
- (f) Deaths without medical attendance. This classification shall be reserved for the following situations:
 - (1) Individual was found dead without obvious or probable cause;
 - (2) Individual was not attended to at any time prior to death by a licensed physician;
 - (3) Individual was not attended to by a licensed physician during a terminal illness, particularly if such illness appears unrelated to a disease previously diagnosed and treated;
 - (4) Fetal deaths where the delivery was handled by a midwife; **
 - (5) Deaths that occur in prison, lock-up, penitentiary, or juvenile justice facility, or when the deceased is in the custody of a government agent or

- authority, unless death is attributed to a cause under subsections (d) or (f)(6); xx
- (6) Deaths that occur during or following an unexplained syncope or coma; **
- (7) Individuals who arrive "Dead on Arrival" (DOA) at the hospital.
- (g) Bodies to be cremated, buried at sea, or shipped off-island when the cause of death is unknown.

The Department of Public Health shall pay for any autopsy that is marked with a (**) above. The Office of the Attorney General shall pay for any autopsy that is marked with a (**xx**) above. The Department of Public Health and the Office of the Attorney General shall decide between themselves on a case by case basis which agency should pay for those autopsies not designated with either a (**) or (**xx**).

The Commissioner of Department of Public Safety is authorized to promulgate these regulations pursuant to Public Law 10-11.

Short Statement of Goals and Objectives:

These rules and regulations are promulgated to amend the Motor Carrier Safety Act of 1996.

Brief Summary of the Rules:

The amendments provide the procedures for motor carriers to ensure safety of commercial motor vehicles on our highways.

The purpose of these amendments are to provide for the transportation of commercial SCUBA divers and their dive tanks consisting of compressed non-flammable gas. This amendment is consistent with similar provisions for the transportation of commercial SCUBA divers and their equipment in vehicles in the United States. The other proposed amendments also reflect the CNMI requirements in transporting workers and the difference in structure between the federal and CNMI regulatory agencies.

MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY REGULATIONS **AMENDMENTS**

I. PURPOSE

These Regulations were adopted on June 13, 1997 pursuant to PL 10-11 and 1 CMC 2501 et seq. They are designed to provide minimum safety requirements for motor carriers and to establish a mechanism of inspection to ensure compliance with the law and these Regulations. These Regulations have been established by the U. S. Department of Transportation. The proposed amendments reflect the difference in structure between the federal and CNMI regulatory agencies. They also reflect the CNMI requirements in transporting workers and commercial SCUBA divers and their dive tanks.

II AMENDMENTS

Section:	Amendment
III-B	References to the Department of Transportation (DOT), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Office of Motor Carrier (OMC) are amended to refer to the Department of Public Safety (DPS).
III-C	References to the Federal Highway Administrator and to the Director are amended to refer to the Commissioner of DPS and to the Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of Motor Carrier.
III-E	Interstate also means intrastate, inter-island and intra-island.
III-G1(a)	"is designed or is used to transport more than 8 passengers including the driver; or,"
III-G1(b)	"has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight

rating of 10,001 or more pounds; or,"

- III-G1(c) "is used in the transportation of hazardous materials of any quantity. Exception: The transportation of passengers with cylinders of compressed non-flammable gas is permitted in the same vehicle for SCUBA purposes. The compressed non-flammable gas must be under 300 pounds (approximately 46 each of 80cft.) The transporting vehicle must also meet the following requirements:
 - (1.) The floor bed must be flat.
 - (2.) It must have suitable racks with adequate means of securing the cylinders.
 - (3.) Tanks must be securely lashed in an upright position and loaded into the racks that are securely attached to the motor vehicle."

Section:	Amendment:
III-J	49 CFR Part 387.27(b)(3) is amended to include: "A motor vehicle carrying less than 9 individuals in a single daily round trip commuting to and from work."
III-K	49 CFR Part 398 is amended to include: construction workers as defined in the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) of 1938 and later amendments.
IV-R	49 CFR 398 is amended to include the established rules concerning the transportation of migrant workers.
V-C	Includes a provision that permits the revision of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) Uniform Out-of-Service(OOS) Criteria to be revised without the necessity of passing specific regulations adopting new criteria.
