

The proposed amendment would provide for a Frequent Commuter Public Parking Permit and provide for an annual and semi-annual fee.

Brief Summary of Proposed

The Public Parking Fee Schedule of the Seaport Division's Terminal Tariff would add a new public parking permit fee at the Port of Saipan for frequent commuters between Saipan and Tinian.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO TERMINAL TARIFF REGULATIONS

Part VI, Subpart H, of the Commonwealth Ports Authority Terminal Tariff Regulations with respect to Public Parking Fees is hereby amended to add a new Subpart H.8, which shall read as follows:

8. Frequent Commuter Parking Permit Fee. Travelers who commute to and from Saipan on a frequent basis may obtain a Frequent Commuter Public Parking Permit from the Commonwealth Ports Authority upon paying in advance the prescribed fee. Such permit shall be prominently displayed inside the vehicle dashboard while parked and shall be presented to the parking attendant when exiting. Such permit shall allow for unlimited parking during the specified permit period.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO **PARTS 12.3 AND 12.15 OF THE** AIRPORT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Citation of Statutory **Authority:**

The Commonwealth Ports Authority proposes to make amendments to its Airport Rules and Regulations with respect to the departure facility service charge, to have a frequent flyer parking fee, and to service/delivery vehicle permit fee, pursuant to its rulemaking authority under 2 CMC § 2122(j) and 1 CMC §9102, 9104(a), and 9105.

Short Statement of Goals and **Objectives:**

CPA wishes to provide for a graduated increase in the departure facility service charge rates that apply at the various airport terminals. CPA also wants to provide a separate public parking fee for frequent flyers and to impose a permit fee for service/delivery vehicles at the airport.

Brief Summary of Proposed Regulations:

The proposed graduated rate increase in the departure facility service charge provides for lower rates than the rates which became effective March 1, 2000. It would also establish frequent flyer parking fee a service/delivery vehicle permit fee.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO PARTS 12.3 AND 12.15 OF THE AIRPORT RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Commonwealth Ports Authority (CPA) hereby amends Part 12.3 (Departure Facility Service Charge) and Part 12.15 (Public Parking Fee) of the Airport Rules and Regulations, as follows:

- (1) Part 12.3 of the Schedule of Fees and Charges of the Airport Rules and Regulations is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 12.3 Departure Facility Service Charge (DFSC)
 - (a) To cover the costs of operations and maintenance of terminal buildings and to service the revenue bond debt payment obligations incurred by the Authority to operate and maintain the various airport facilities, a departure facility service charge shall be assessed each aircraft operator, which charge shall be calculated on a per revenue passenger basis as follows:
 - (1) The DFSC at Saipan International Airport for FY 2001 shall be \$6.35 per passenger; for FY 2002, it shall be \$6.90 per passenger; for FY 2003, it shall be \$7.45 per passenger; and for FY 2004 and thereafter, it shall be \$8.00 per passenger.
 - (2) The DFSC at Rota International Airport and at West Tinian Airport for FY 2001 shall be \$4.58 per passenger; for FY 2002, it shall be \$4.70 per passenger; for FY 2003, it shall be \$4.82 per passenger; and for FY 2004 and thereafter, it shall be \$4.95 per passenger.
 - (3) The DFSC at the Saipan Commuter Terminal for FY 2001 shall be \$2.98 per passenger; for FY 2002, it shall be \$3.10 per passenger; for FY 2003, it shall be \$3.25 per passenger; and for FY 2004 and thereafter, it shall be \$3.35 per passenger.
 - (b) The DFSC schedule set forth in paragraph (a) above shall be paid to the Authority by every aircraft operator transporting revenue passengers from such airports. Diplomatic aircraft and U. S. Military aircraft are exempted from the departure facility service charge.

- (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing departure facility service charge schedule, the Commonwealth Ports Authority may provide to signatory airlines servicing the airports of the Commonwealth, an Airline Incentive Fee Discount on the applicable departure facility service charge, the passenger arrival fee, and other airport fees and charges, based on a discount rate which the Authority determines to be reasonable and appropriate under the circumstances, taking into account the Authority's financial condition, the Authority's future revenue projection, the Authority's revenue bond debt service obligations, and its operations and maintenance expenses. The Airline Incentive Fee Discount Program is intended to encourage the signatory airlines to bring in more visitors to the Commonwealth and stimulate its economy.
- (d) The foregoing amendments shall retroactively commence on January 1, 2001.
- (2) Part 12.15 relating to public parking fee is amended to hereafter read:

12.15 Public Parking Fee

All vehicles owned by members of the general public shall park their vehicles in designated public parking areas, and shall pay a public parking fee, as follows:

NOTICE OF EMERGENCY REPEAL AND REENACTMENT TO CUSTOMS REGULATIONS REGARDING CUSTOMS, IMMIGRATION AND QUARRANTINE (CIQ) CHARGES

EMERGENCY: The Secretary of Finance finds that current CIQ charges for smaller aircraft are a financial hardship to the airline operators, given the current economic crisis. The Secretary of Finance further finds that the public interest requires the emergency repeal and re-enactment to the Customs Regulations Section 1302.22(e)(1).

REASON FOR THE EMERGENCY: The Secretary of Finance hereby finds that adoption of these emergency regulations is in the public interest due to the fact that it is necessary to expand the tourism base and increase the number of visitors to the Commonwealth. The secretary also finds that the Asian economic crisis has had a direct and substantial adverse impact on the Commonwealth's tourist arrivals, and airlines servicing the Commonwealth have reacted to the drop in arrivals by either redirecting or decreasing the number of direct flights to the Commonwealth in recent years. Finally, the Secretary finds that it is critical to the efforts to expand the Commonwealth's tourism industry to maintain positive relationships with airlines currently serving the Commonwealth; to be competitive in the area with respect to fees charged to airlines for serving our islands; and to create incentives to induce existing airlines to maintain flights to the Commonwealth.

<u>CONTENTS</u>: The current overtime charges for flights arriving after normal working hours is established at a flat rate of \$35.00 per flight in addition to the per arriving passenger fee of a flat \$1.00 and per cargo pound rates. These regulations will amend the per flight and per arriving passenger rate for airlines having a gross weight of less than 20 tons.

INTENT TO ADOPT: The Secretary of Finance intends to adopt this emergency regulation as a permanent regulation pursuant to 1 CMC §9104(a)(1) and (2), and therefore publishes in the Commonwealth Register this notice of opportunity to submit comments. Comments regarding the contents of those regulations may be sent to the Secretary of Finance, Department of Finance, PO Box 5234 Saipan, MP 96950, within thirty (30) days.

<u>AUTHORITY:</u> The Secretary of Finance is authorized to adopt and issue regulations under 1 CMC §2553 and §2557.

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EMERGENCY AMENDMENT TO CUSTOMS REGULATIONS REGARDING CUSTOMS, IMMIGRATION AND QUARRANTINE (CIQ) CHARGES

Citation of Statutory Authority:

The authority for promulgation and issuance of these Emergency Customs Regulations is by virtue of the authority and directions set forth in the Commonwealth Code, including, but not limited to 1 CMC §2553, 1 CMC §2557, 4 CMC §1104, 4 CMC §1402(d), and 4 CMC §1818.

Short Statement of Goals and Objectives:

To allow for amendment of Customs Service Regulation Number 1300, Section 1302.33(e)(1), proposed in Commonwealth register Vol. 15, No. 1, January 15, 1993, and adopted in the Commonwealth Register, Vol. 15, No. 3, March 15, 1993 at page 10501. Section 1302.33(e)(1) remains in effect pursuant to Customs Service Regulation 4300, Section 4300.3. This amendment will provide for reduced CIQ charges for airplanes with a gross weight of less than 20 tons and for passengers on those planes. This will assist in expanding the tourism base and increase the number of visitors to the Commonwealth.

Brief Summary of the Rule:

The Department of Finance, Division of Customs, is authorized to charge overtime CIQ fees on airplanes arriving after normal working hours. The flat rate per flight is \$35.00 and a per passenger rate of \$1.00. This emergency regulation will reduce that rate for flights and the rate for per arriving passenger for airplanes with a gross weight of less than 20 tons.

EMERGENCY REPEAL AND REENACTMENT TO CUSTOMS REGULATIONS REGARDING CUSTOMS, IMMIGRATION AND QUARRANTINE (CIQ) CHARGES

The emergency repeal and reenactment to Customs Regulation §1302.33(e)(1), Commonwealth Register Vol. 15, No. 1, January 15, 1993, as in effect pursuant to Customs Regulation Section 4300.3, Commonwealth Register Vol. 18 No. 12, December 15, 1996 is as follows:

Section 1302.33(e) is repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(1)(A) General Rule for Charges After Normal Working Hours. For the purposes of application, a standard rate in lieu of overtime charges of the Customs Division will be included and billed using a flat rate that also includes the overtime charges of the Immigration and Quarantine Divisions. This rate will be applied to the following flight particulars for work performed after normal working hours:

Per Flight over 20 tons gross weight	\$35.00
Per Flight under 20 tons gross weight	\$17.50
Per Arriving Passenger for planes over 20 tons gross weight	\$ 1.00
Per Arriving Passenger for planes under 20 tons gross weight	\$.50
Per Cargo Lb.	\$.035

(B) "After Normal Working Hours" is work performed:

- (i) for flights and passengers:
 - (a) Weekdays work performed between the hours of 4:30 p.m. through 7:30 a.m. the next day, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.
 - (b) Holidays work performed during the 24 hour period of a holiday.
 - (c) Weekends work performed after 4:30 p.m. Friday through 7:30 a.m. Monday.
- (ii) for cargo:
 - (a) Weekdays cargo arriving between 4:30 p.m. through 8:00 p.m.
 - (b) Holidays cargo arriving after 4:30 p.m. the day preceding a holiday up to 8:00 p.m. the day of the holiday. (i) If the holiday falls on Friday, the chargeable hours shall start after 4:30 p.m. Thursday and continue through 8:00 p.m. Sunday. (ii) If the holiday falls on a Monday, the weekend chargeable hours shall continue through the weekend up to 8:00 p.m. Monday.
 - (c) Weekends cargo arriving after 4:30 p.m. Friday up to 8:00 p.m. Sunday.
 - (d) No Service no cargo service will be provided from 8:00 p.m. through 7:30 a.m. the following morning.

- (2) <u>Application of Overtime Pay.</u> All air and sea carriers and other persons whose operations require the service of a Customs agent of the Commonwealth Government of the Northern Mariana Islands after normal working hours shall be charged with the overtime pay of the Customs agent(s) rendering the service as follows:
 - (a) <u>Unscheduled flights, and any arrival at the seaport.</u> Service of less than two (2) hours for each arrival shall be charged with the minimum of two (2) hours overtime. Any fraction of an hour in excess of the two (2) hours minimum is charged a full hour. The charge shall commence upon arrival of the Customs Officer(s) at the post of duty.
 - (b) Sea carriers, individuals, non-scheduled aircraft and others for which overtime services can be specifically assigned shall be charged for the actual overtime incurred by the Customs, Immigration or Quarantine agent(s) providing such services. There shall be a minimum two (2) hour charge as provided in subparagraph (a).
 - (c) Said overtime charges and holiday charges shall be waived when services are rendered to a carrier operating under emergency conditions or for emergency purposes.
- (3) <u>Cargo Originating Outside of the CNMI.</u> All cargo which originates outside of the CNMI and which is being transported from the first point of entry in the CNMI shall be inspected at the final point of entry. All cargo inspections, regardless of the location of the inspection shall be subject to the CIQ rules of this regulation.
