

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC AUDITOR PERSONNEL REGULATIONS

The Public Auditor in accordance with the authority vested in him pursuant to 1 CMC §2305(b) hereby provides public notice of the proposed amendments to Section 4.3 (Annual Leave) of the Office of the Public Auditor Personnel Regulations. The Proposed Amendments to the Office of the Public Auditor Personnel Regulations amend the annual leave provision in the existing regulation to limit the amount of annual leave permitted to be accumulated by an employee to 360 hours. The revisions contained in this amendment add a new sub-section 4.3.4 to the existing Section 4.3.

The Proposed Amendments to the Office of the Public Auditor Personnel Regulations are published in the Commonwealth Register. Copies of the proposed rules and regulations may be obtained from the Office of the Public Auditor, 1236 Yap Drive, Capitol Hill, P.O. Box 501399, Saipan, MP 96950.

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PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC AUDITOR PERSONNEL REGULATIONS

Citation of Statutory Authority	1 CMC §2305(b)authorizes the Public Auditor to establish supplemental personnel regulations for the Office of the Public Auditor.
Short Statement of Goals & Objective:	The purpose of the proposed amendments to Section 4.3 (Annual Leave) the Personnel Regulations of the Office of the Public Auditor is to limit the number of annual leave hours permitted to be accumulated by Office of the Public Auditor Staff to 360 hours. A similar provision exists in the CNMI Civil Service and Excepted Service Regulations. OPA is amending this provision to mirror the benefits provided to the employees covered by the Excepted and Civil Service Regulations and to limit the fiscal impact felt when employees terminate their employment with the office who have accumulated excessive amounts of annual leave.
Brief Summary of the Proposed Rule:	The proposed amendment to Section 4.3 (Annual Leave) of the Office of the Public Auditor Rules and Regulations limits the amount of annual leave an employee can accumulate to 360 hours. Currently employees are permitted to accumulate annual leave without limit.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 4.3 (ANNUAL LEAVE)OF THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC AUDITOR PERSONNEL REGULATIONS

Section 4.3 is amended to include a new section 4.3.4 as follows:

4.3.4 <u>Maximum Accumulation</u> The maximum accumulation of annual leave for employees shall be three hundred sixty (360) hours. Accrued annual leave in excess of 360 hours remaining at the end of the leave year shall be converted to sick leave.
