

EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY Volcanic Activity on Anatahan

WHEREAS, On May 13, 2003, a Declaration of Emergency was issued with respect to volcanic activity on the island of Anatahan; and

WHEREAS, said Declaration declared the island of Anatahan as unsafe for human habitation and restricted all travel to said island with the exception of scientific expeditions; and

WHEREAS, the volcanic activity and seismic phenomena which prompted said Declaration continues to exist on the island of Anatahan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO R. FITIAL, by the authority vested in me as Governor, and pursuant to Article III, Section 10 of the Commonwealth Constitution and 3 CMC §5121, do hereby extend a state of disaster emergency in the Commonwealth with respect to the island of Anatahan under the same terms and conditions as are contained in the original Declaration.

This Extension of Emergency shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days, unless the Governor shall, prior to the end of the 30-day period, notify the Presiding Officers of the Legislature that the state of emergency has been revoked or further extended for alike term, and giving reasons for extending the emergency.

HERE IS THE LATEST INFORMATION ON TROPICAL STORM KONG REY 01W AS RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE, TIYAN, GUAM, AND COMPILED AT THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICE, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

AS OF 4:00 PM THIS AFTERNOON, TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY 01W WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 10.2 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE 152.1 DEGREES EAST, OR ABOUT 545 MILES SOUTHEAST OF SAIPAN AND TINIAN AND 540 MILES EAST SOUTHEAST OF ROTA. TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 16 MILES PER HOUR WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 50 MILES PER HOUR.

THIS GENERAL MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE DURING THE NEXT 24 HOURS. TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY IS EXPECTED TO INTENSIFY OVER NIGHT AND MAY BECOME A TYPHOON BY MONDAY MORNING.

HERE IS THE LATEST INFORMATION ON TYPHOON KONG REY 01W AS RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE, TIYAN, GUAM, AND COMPILED AT THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICE, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

AS OF 1:00 P.M. THIS AFTERNOON, TYPHOON KONG REY 01W WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 12.2 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE 149.1 DEGREES EAST, OR ABOUT 305 MILES SOUTHEAST OF SAIPAN AND TINIAN AND 295 MILES EAST SOUTHEAST OF ROTA.

TYPHOON KONG-REY IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT AN AVERAGE SPEED OF 15 MILES PER HOUR. A NORTHWEST TO NORTH-NORTHWEST TRACK IS EXPECTED OVER THE NEXT 12 TO 24 HOURS WITH A SLIGHT DECREASE IN FORWARD SPEED. MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS HAVE INCREASED TO 75 MPH. TYPHOON KONG REY IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE TO INTENSIFY WITHIN THE NEXT 24 HOURS.

TYPHOON FORCE WINDS OF 74 MILES PER HOUR OR MORE EXISTT AROUND THE CORE OF THE DEVELOPING EYEWALL. TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS OF 39 MPH OR MORE EXTEND OUT TO 150 MILES NORTH OF THE CENTER AND 90 MILES SOUTH OF THE CENTER.

PUBLIC NOTICE OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS WHICH ARE AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH ZONING BOARD

AND WHICH ACCOMPANY PROPOSED REGULATIONS

EMERGENCY: The Zoning Board finds that, pursuant to its organic act, see 2 CMC § 7221 (d), and the Saipan Zoning Law, 10 CMC §§ 1000 – 15200, it is required to undertake its responsibilities, including the approvals of permit requests, reviews of plans and responses to requests for copies of public documents. However, there has been no fee schedule in place for these activities. It is necessary to put a fee schedule in place so that the Board and the Zoning Administrator can charge fair fees for these activities.

REASONS FOR EMERGENCY: The Board has already received requests for approval and for copies of documents. In order to timely respond to these and other requests it is imperative that the Board put in place a publicly available schedule of fees and charges, while it promulgates fee regulations. The public interest so requires.

ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS FOR 120 DAYS: The Zoning Board has followed the procedures of 1 CMC § 9104(b) to adopt the Proposed Regulations for fees, and now seeks to do so on an emergency basis for 120 days (1 CMC § 9105(b)(2) (emergency regulations)). These emergency regulations become effective immediately upon filing with the Register. (*Id.*)

DIRECTIONS FOR FILING AND PUBLICATION: These Emergency Regulations shall be published in the Commonwealth Register. The Board's Chairman has instructed the Zoning Administrator to take appropriate measures to make these Emergency Regulations known to the persons who may be affected by them (1 CMC § 9105(b)(2)).

DECLARATION: By his duly authorized signature, the Chairman of the Zoning Board declares that the attached regulations are required on an emergency basis by the public interest and shall be in effect for 120 days. (1 CMC § 9105(b)(2)). By his signature, the Governor concurs. (1 CMC § 9104(b).

- (1) In addition to the application fee, the applicant shall reimburse the Zoning Board for the costs of professional engineers and other consultants hired by the Zoning Administrator to review and inspect the applicant's proposal when the Zoning Board is unable to do so with existing in-house staff. These professional services may include, but are not limited to: legal; planning; hearing examiner; environmental review; financial; accounting; soils; and civil, environmental, traffic, mechanical, and structural engineering. In the event that a project requires special staff analysis beyond that which is included in the base fee, the applicant shall reimburse the Zoning Board at a rate of \$25.00 per hour for this extra staff time. The Zoning Administrator may require the applicant to deposit an amount with the CNMI Treasurer to cover anticipated costs of retaining professional consultants or performing special staff analysis.
- (2) If a permit category is not listed, the Zoning Administrator or his/her designee shall determine the fee schedule for that category, subject to Zoning Board approval.
- (3) In the event of unique and unusual circumstances or economic hardship, the Zoning Administrator may waive or reduce a fee. The Zoning Administrator shall notify the Zoning Board of any waivers or reductions, and shall rescind any charges deemed inappropriate by the Zoning Board.
- (b) Fees for documents shall be as follows:

- (1) Photocopies: less than 20 copies –no charge; 21 or more copies \$0.50 per page
- (2) Electronic files on CD: \$10.00 for each CD
- (3) Electronic files on DVD: \$20.00 for each DVD
- (4) Copies of meeting minutes on cassette tape: \$15.00 per tape
- (5) If complying with a request for information takes longer than one hour, labor shall be charged at the rate of \$20.00 per hour.
