ACTION TO ADOPT PROPOSED REGULATIONS: The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Coastal Resource Management Regulatory Agencies (CRM Regulatory Agencies) HEREBY ADOPT AS PERMANENT the Proposed Regulations which were published in the Commonwealth Register at the above-referenced pages, pursuant to the procedures of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), 1 CMC § 9104(a). The CRM Regulatory Agencies announced that they intended to adopt these regulations as permanent, and now do so. I also certify by signature below that: as published, such Adopted Regulations are a true, complete, and correct copy of the referenced Proposed Regulations, and that they are being adopted with only the modifications described below.

**PRIOR PUBLICATION**: The prior publication was as stated above.

MODIFICATIONS FROM PROPOSED REGULATIONS, IF ANY: In response to comments received, the Proposed Regulations were modified as follows:

- Added CUC's wastewater threshold to major siting definition (§ 15-10-020(uu)(10));
- Adjusted typo in "stand vegetation" (should be "strand")(§ 15-10-345(b)(1)); and
- Adjusted typo in shoreline lots description "the applicant for high rise development on a lot adjacent to the shoreline lots" has also been corrected (second lots omitted) (§ 15-10-350(c)(1)(ii)).

**AUTHORITY:** The CRM Regulatory Agencies are jointly empowered by the Legislature with the authority to adopt and modify rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of the Commonwealth Coastal Resources Management Act. 2 CMC §§ 1531(b)–(d).

THE TERMS AND SUBSTANCE: The Adopted Regulations represent a comprehensive revision to the Coastal Resources Management Regulations and are in conformity with the CRM Regulatory Agencies' obligation to operate by regulation a coastal resources management program consistent with the coastal resource management policies in 2 CMC § 151 1. 2 CMC §§ 1512(1) and 1531(b). The Adopted Regulations include minor grammar and punctuation updates, clarified terms, updated policies, and amend sections on authority, definitions, jurisdiction, permit requirements, permit process and fees, permit review standards and Areas of Particular Concern

(APC) guidelines, major siting review procedures, permit extension and amendment fees, enforcement actions, and federal consistency language. For an exhaustive list of the subjects and issues involved, see the above-referenced page numbers in the Commonwealth Register for the Proposed Regulations.



# PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH ARE AMENDMENTS TO THE TITLE 72: DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

INTENDED ACTION: The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services ("DFEMS"), intends to adopt as permanent regulations the attached Proposed Regulations, pursuant to the procedures of the Administrative Procedure Act, 1 CMC § 9104(a). The Regulations will become effective 10 days after adoption and publication in the Commonwealth Register.

**AUTHORITY:** DFEMS is empowered by the Legislature to adopt rules and regulations regarding Fire Lanes and their use pursuant to PL 19-69, the Commonwealth Fire Lane Act of 2016.

**TERMS AND SUBSTANCE:** The proposed regulation provides for additions to Title 72 by establishing fire lanes upon public property in the Commonwealth and enforcement mechanisms to maintain them, including but not limited to fines and towing.

SUBJECTS AND ISSUES INVOLVED: These amendments include the following areas:

- 1. The creation of fire lanes,
- 2. the marking of fire lanes, and
- 3. a fine, towing, and auction scheme for removal of obstructions to fire lanes.

REGULATIONS BEING AMENDED: Title 72. Chapter 72-10 Part 400.

DIRECTIONS FOR FILING AND PUBLICATION: These proposed regulations shall be published in the Commonwealth Register in the section on proposed and newly adopted regulations (1 CMC § 9102(a)(1)) and notice of the intended action to adopt this proposed regulation shall be posted in convenient places in the civic center and in local government offices in each senatorial district, both in English and in the principal vernacular (1 CMC § 9104(a)(1)).

#### PROPOSED FIRE LANE REGULATION

Northern Mariana Islands Administrative Code Regulation Title:

Title 72 (Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services)

Chapter 72-10 (Administration of the Fire Safety Code Rules and

Regulations)

Sections, 72-10-001 (General Provisions), 72-10-400 (Fire Lane Safety)

#### Section I

NMIAC § 72-10-001 is hereby amended to read as follows as follows:

#### § 72-10-001 Authority

The Department of Public Safety Fire Division, Fire Prevention and Arson Investigation Unit Fire and Emergency Medical Services, is empowered by the Legislature to adopt regulations for the administration and enforcement of the Fire Code Safety Act of 1998 and the creation of fire lanes. See 1 CMC § <del>2507(a)</del>28001; 1 CMC 28062; and 2 CMC §§ 7339(f), 7340(a).

#### Section II

NMIAC § 72-10-400 is hereby amended to read as follows as follows:

#### **PART 400**

§72-10-401

#### **Definitions**

- a) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services.
- b) "Department" means the Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services.
- c) "Fire lane" means the unobstructed area or passageway within any public right-of-way, easement or private property designated for fire trucks and other firefighting or emergency vehicles and equipment to use, travel upon and/or park.
- d) "Cancelled tow" or "curb release)" means the release of a vehicle after the tow operator has arrived at the scene of the vehicle to be towed and commenced preparations for towing.
- e) "Rotational tow" means transportation of a vehicle by a commercial towing vehicle pursuant to contract or rotational tow program with the Department.
- f) "Tow operator" or "towing operator" means any person or entity providing towing services;
- g) "Towing" or "to tow" means to carry, draw or pull along a vehicle by means of a commercial tow vehicle or car carrier.

#### \$72-10-405

#### Designation

The Commissioner shall require the establishment of a designated fire lane on public right-of-way for the orderly access of fire and other emergency vehicles and equipment to the premises. The Commissioner shall establish such fire lane by written order designating and describing such lane.

#### §72-10-410

#### 1. Markings and Signs

All designated fire lanes shall be clearly marked in one of the following manners:

- (a) Vertical curbs shall be painted red on the top and side, extending the length of the designated fire lane. The pavement adjacent to the painted curbs shall be marked with block lettering a minimum of 5 inches in height and with a three inch brush stroke reading: "No Parking Fire Lane." Lettering shall be white and spaced at no more than 20-foot intervals.
- (b) Rolled curbs or surface without curbs shall have a red six-inch-wide stripe painted extending the length of the designated fire lane. The surface adjacent to the strip shall be marked with block lettering a minimum of 6 inches in height and with a minimum three-inch brush stroke reading: "No Parking Fire Lane." Lettering shall be in yellow and spaced at no more than 20-foot intervals.
- (c) Fire lane signs shall be as follows:
  - (1) Reflective in nature.
  - (2) Use red letters on white background.
  - (3) Use three-inch lettering, to read "No Parking Fire Lane."
  - (4) A minimum of 12 inches wide by 18 inches height.
  - (5) Spaced no more than 50 feet apart and posted on or immediately next to the curb or side of the road.
  - (6) Top of the sign to be not less than four feet nor more than six feet from the ground.
  - (7) Signs may be placed on a building when approved by the Commissioner.
  - (8) When posts are required for signs, they shall be a minimum of two inch galvanized steel or four-inch by four-inch pressure treated wood.
  - (9) Signs are to be placed so they face the direction of vehicular travel.

At each entrance to property where fire lanes have been designated or at regular intervals in areas that do not have an entrance proper, signs shall be posted as set forth in this article, in a clear, conspicuous location and shall clearly state "Vehicles parked in Fire Lanes shall be towed and

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impounded."They shall also state the name, telephone number, and address of the towing company or other entity where the vehicle may be redeemed.

#### 2. Maintenance of Markings and Signs

The fire lane markings on public land shall be maintained by the Department, and as often as is deemed necessary to clearly identify the designated area as a fire lane. If there is no public property owner of a designated fire lane, the Commissioner shall maintain the designated fire lane using the funds from the Fire Lane Revolving Fund. The Commissioner shall notify in writing the property owner if the fire lane markings on private property need to be maintained.

#### §72-10-415

#### **Enforcement**

#### 1. Citation

Any person who parks a vehicle in, allows the parking of a vehicle in, obstructs or allows the obstruction of a designated fire lane or who fails to mark or maintain the marking of a designated fire lane as prescribed in this article, or is guilty of an infraction.

The maximum penalty for parking a vehicle in, allowing the parking of a vehicle in, obstructing, or allowing the obstruction of a designated fire lane, shall be not more than a fine of \$150 per offense. Each day or part of a day during which the unlawful act or violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

The maximum penalty for failing to mark or maintain the marking of a designated fire lane shall be not more than a fine of \$150 per offense.

#### 2. Towing

The obstruction of a designated fire lane by a parked vehicle or any other object is prohibited and shall constitute a traffic and fire hazard and is considered an immediate hazard to life and property.

- (a) A police officer from the Department of Public Safety or a Firefighter from the Department of Fire and EMS shall immediately remove, or cause the removal of, a vehicle in violation of any provision in this article.
- (b) A police officer or Firefighter shall issue a citation to the registered owner of the vehicle for a violation of this article.

The Department shall set fees for all towing services to include cancelled tows to be paid by the towed vehicles registered owner.

The Department may have its own towing truck or may procure the services of a towing company with certain class of tow trucks with requirements on availability and access, liability and insurance

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coverage. All contracted tow services shall be obtained through proper CNMI Procurement Process.

#### 3. Impoundment

All vehicles towed under this authority shall be taken immediately to a designated impound facility. The Department may maintain its own impoundment facility or contract the services of a facility with consideration of appropriate security for the impounded vehicles, availability and access, liability and insurance. The Department shall set a daily impound fee for each vehicle stored in the designated impound lot. All contracted facilities shall be obtained through proper CNMI Procurement Process.

When a towed vehicle arrives at the impoundment lot, the first day storage will begin. Charges for two days storage cannot occur unless the car is held over 8 hours. (For instance, if a car comes in on the 1st at 11pm and is picked up at 5am on the 2nd that is one day storage. If the car comes in at 11pm on the 1st and picked up at 9am on the 2nd, this would be two day storage fees.)

#### 4. Release from Impoundment

The registered owner or his/her representative shall contact the Department within regular business hours to arrange for the release of their vehicle impounded.

The Department shall assess the registered owner or his/her representative with the total cost of the all fines and fees related in citing, towing and impounding the vehicle. All associated fines and fees must be paid to the CNMI Treasury before the vehicle is released to the owner.

The associated fines and fees shall be calculated on the citation and the owner or representative will be directed to make payment to the CNMI Treasury. A copy of the CNMI treasury receipt shall be provided to the Department on the same day. Each delay in days will be re-calculated based on the daily impoundment/storage fee.

Once payment has been verified, a release slip shall be issued to the owner and or representative who will presented it to the impound lot. The Department shall contact the impound lot and advise and confirm of payment and to release the vehicle. This transaction and release of impounded vehicles shall only be done during regular business hours. All transactions related in the release of vehicles after regular business hours will require additional costs to include overtime rate for Department personnel and the impound facility. Such additional charges will be paid by the registered owner or representative before such release is made.

#### 5. Notification of Impoundment to Registered Owner

When the owner of a vehicle does not release their vehicles within 5 business days, the Department shall make reasonable efforts to contact the owner and inform them of the need to release their vehicle. The registered own is given up to 15 days to effectuate a release. Additional days may be made if the owner is off island and the Department receives an official request via written letter,

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email, or fax. All additional storage days shall be assessed and charged to the registered owner before the vehicle is release. All costs shall be paid to the CNMI Treasury.

#### 6. Notification of Impoundment to Lien Holder

If the registered owner of the vehicle fails to make the effort to release their vehicle from the impound lot and the Department has made reasonable effort to reach the owner then the Department shall notify the lien holder of the impoundment and the procedures to release the vehicle. The lien holder has 10 business days from notice of the impoundment to effectuate a release of the vehicle from the impound lot. The total cost associated to release the vehicle to include citation, towing, impoundment and administrative cost related in reaching the lien holder shall be assessed to the lien holder before the vehicle is released. All costs shall be aid to the CNMI Treasury.

#### 7. Auction if not Released

If the vehicle's lien holder fails to release the vehicle within 30 days from the impound lot then the Department shall auction the vehicle to pay for the cost of the citation, towing, impoundment, storage, and administrative cost associated in releasing the vehicle.

The Department will coordinate with the Division of Procurement and Supply of the Department of Finance to initiate, conduct, and finalize the auction and payment to the CNMI.

#### §72-10-420

#### Fire Lane Revolving Fund

The fines and fees collected pursuant to this article and any regulations promulgated by the Commissioner shall be deposited in the Fire Lane Revolving Fund;

- (a) The funds shall be used for the purpose of establishing and maintaining fire lanes.
- (b) enforcement of PL 19-69 and all DFEMS operations, and
- (c) training for the Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services. and

The Commissioner shall be the expenditure authority of the Fire Lane Revolving Fund.

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH ARE AMENDMENTS TO RULES AND REGULATIONS **REGARDING CHAPTER 60-30.2 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM RULES AND REGULATIONS** 

PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS: The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System (PSS) finds that:

INTENDED ACTION TO ADOPT THESE PROPOSED RULES AND **REGULATIONS:** The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System intends to adopt as pennanent regulations the attached Proposed Regulations, pursuant to the procedures of the Administrative Procedure Act, 1 CMC § 9104(a). The Regulations would become effective ten (10) days after adoption and publication in the Commonwealth Register. (1 CMC § 9105(b))

**AUTHORITY:** The proposed amendments to PSS regulations are promulgated pursuant to the Board's authority as provided by Article XV of the CNMI Constitution, Public Law 6-10 and the CNMI Administrative Procedures Act.

THE TERMS AND SUBSTANCE: The proposed amendment set forth to provide new eligibility requirements by removing Praxis I in §60-30.2-142 Procedure, §60-30.2-144 Timeline, §60-30.2-220 Eligibility for All Five Certifications, §60-30.2-225 Type of Certification and Requirements.

THE SUBJECTS AND ISSUES INVOLVED: The Proposed Regulation sets forth new eligibility requirements removing Praxis I.

**PROPOSED REGULATIONS:** The Proposed Regulation seeks to amend the following provisions within PSS § 60-30.2 in the following manner:

PSS §60-30.2-142 (a), (b), (c) Procedure by adding the underscored paragraph:

All current PSS teachers and teacher applicants shall be required to pass PRAXIS II prior to (Effective Date of Regulation).

(a) All current PSS teachers and teacher applicants shall be required to pass PRAXIS II (Effective Date of Regulation).

All current PSS librarians and librarian applicants shall be required to pass PRAXIS II prior to (Effective Date of Regulation).

(a) All current PSS librarians and librarian applicants shall be required to pass PRAXIS II prior to (Effective Date of Regulation).

The results of the PRAXIS II examinations will determine a current librarian or teacher's eligibility for contract renewal and an applicant's eligibility for employment.

(c) The results of the PRAXIS II examinations will determine a current librarian or teacher's eligibility for contract renewal and an applicant's eligibility for employment.

All newly recruited PSS teachers for SY 17/18 shall be required to have taken and pass the PRAXIS II examinations in order to qualify for employment with PSS.

(Effective Date of Regulation), All teachers employed by PSS will have taken and passed the PRAXIS II exams.

(d) Core Knowledge Examination: All certification applicants, excluding professionally licensed related services providers, must take and pass PRAXIS exams starting August 1, 2006. All basic I, basic II, standard and professional certification applications must take and pass PRAXIS II.

PSS §60-30.2-225 (a)(3) by removing the understored paragraph.

... For CNMI PSS, employee must take and pass Praxis I (PPST).

PSS §60-30.2-225 (2)(i)(D) by removing the underscored paragraph.

Test result showing that an applicant has taken and passed PRAXIS I

PSS  $\S$  60-30.2-225(b)(1)(C)(7) by adding the underscored paragraph.

(Effective Date of Regulation): Test result showing that an applicant has taken and passed the PRAXIS II exam, excluding professionally licensed related services providers.

- (a) PSS § 60-30.2-225(b)(D)(3)(i)(D) to read as follows:" "Test result showing that a teacher applicant, excluding professionally licensed related services providers, has taken and passed PRAXIS I and II exams the PRAXIS II exam.
- (b) PSS § 60-30.2-225(b)(D)(3)(iii) to read as follows: "Term. The basic II certificate shall be issued and valid for a period of three years. The basic II certificate is invalid after its expiration date and shall not be reissued, be renewable by the issuing authority if the employee shows proof of eligibility for the basic II certificate.

This section (60-30.2-225 (b)(D)(3)(iii) should be in the Alternative Certification proposed notice. This notice is only for Praxis I.

DIRECTIONS FOR FILING AND PUBLICATION: These Proposed Regulations shall be published in the Commonwealth Register in the section on proposed and newly adopted regulations. (1 CMC § 9102(a) (1) and posted in convenient places in the civic center and in local government offices in each senatorial district, both in English and in the principal vernacular. (1 CMC § 9104 (a) (1))

**PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS:** The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System (PSS) finds that:

#### INTENDED ACTION TO ADOPT THESE PROPOSED RULES AND

**REGULATIONS:** The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System intends to adopt as permanent regulations the attached Proposed Regulations, pursuant to the procedures of the Administrative Procedure Act, I CMC § 9104(a). The Regulations would become effective ten (10) days after adoption and publication in the Commonwealth Register. (1 CMC § 9105(b))

**AUTHORITY:** The proposed amendments to PSS regulations are promulgated pursuant to the Board's authority as provided by Article XV of the CNMI Constitution, Public Law 6-10 and the CNMI Administrative Procedures Act.

**THE TERMS AND SUBSTANCE:** The proposed amendment set forth to provide amendments to the certification Part 200 Certification: Classification and Salary Schedule, PSS §§ 60-30.2-220 Eligibility for All Five Certifications and 60-30.2-225 Types of Certification and Requirements.

**THE SUBJECTS AND ISSUES INVOLVED:** The Proposed Regulation sets forth alternative certifications for Teacher, Chamorro Carolinian Language Heritage Studies (CCLHS), Early Childhood Infants and Toddlers, Early Childhood Pre-K and Instructors.

**PROPOSED REGULATIONS:** The Proposed Regulation seeks to amend the certification requirements in the following manner:

- 1. Alternative Certification for Teacher
- 2. Alternative Certification for CCLHS
- 3. Alternative Certification for Career Technical Education (CTE)
- 4. Alternative Certification for Early Childhood Infants and Toddlers
- 5. Alternative Certification for Early Childhood Pre-K
- 6. Alternative Certification for Instructors

DIRECTIONS FOR FILING AND PUBLICATION: These Proposed Regulations shall be published in the Commonwealth Register in the section on proposed and newly adopted regulations. (1 CMC § 9102(a) (1) and posted in convenient places in the civic center and in local government offices in each senatorial district, both in English and in the principal vernacular. (1 CMC § 9104 (a) (1))
