**§ 2599. Casino Operator May Accept Credit Wagers, etc.**

(a) A casino operator or an authorized employee of a casino operator may, in connection with any gaming:

- (1) accept a credit wager from any person;
- (2) issue credit to a licensed junket enterprise;
- (3) provide cash or chips to any person in respect of a credit card transaction;

(b) Credit in any form shall be considered the same as money and any sum received in payment for credit extended by a licensee to a patron for purposes of gaming or for the issuance of a chip for gaming is a sum received from the conduct of gaming as that term used in 10 CMC § 2513(i), defining “casino gross revenue.”

(c) A casino operator shall not in connection with any gaming, release or discharge, in whole or in part a debt owing by any person without first submitting the prescribed information and material to the Commission.

(d) Nothing contained in subsection (a) of this section limits the operation of the provisions of 10 CMC § 25102.
