Single family dwellings and duplexes not requiring special architectural or engineering design shall comply with the requirements of Part I (Section R-115), Parts II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII and the appendices of the 1986 edition of the Council of American Building Officials (CABO) Code for one and two family dwellings. Requirements for such dwellings in the Uniform Building Code are superseded by the adoption of the CABO Code in this section.
