

TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES
DIVISION 1: EDUCATION

§ 1104. Definitions.

- (a) “Board” means the CNMI State Board of Education.
- (b) “Commissioner” means the Chief Executive Officer of the Public School System as selected by the Board of Education.
- (c) “Preschool” means programs of instruction for students either four (4) or five (5) years of age.
- (d) “Elementary education” means kindergarten through fifth (5th) grade.
- (e) “Middle School education” means grades six (6) through eight (8).
- (f) “Secondary education” means grades nine (9) through twelve (12).
- (g) “Students” means any child enrolled in the CNMI Public School System from kindergarten to twelfth (12th) grade.
- (h) “Public School System” means the public education school system which shall serve as the State and Local Education Agency for preschool, elementary, middle and secondary school programs.
