§ 2103. Noncompliance: Provisional Entrance to School.

(a) A child may enter school provisionally upon submitting written proof from a licensed physician or the Department of Public Health and Environmental Services stating that the child is in the process of receiving the required immunizations or tuberculin test. Further certification showing that the required immunizations and tuberculin test have been completed must be submitted to the appropriate school official no later than three months after the child first entered the school.
