§ 2551. Short Title.

This article shall be known as the Patient's Rights Act. The rights set forth in this article shall be afforded every person receiving assessment, evaluation, care or treatment at an evaluation or treatment facility, whether voluntarily or involuntarily, inpatient or outpatient.
