§ 3108. Limitation on Powers and Duties.

Effective April 1, 1977, the powers and duties of the Social Security Administrator and the Appellate Examiner described in 3 CMC §§ 3102 and 3106 do not include powers and duties relating to the administration, collection, assessment, and enforcement of the contributions imposed by 3 CMC §§ 3501, 3502 and 3505, except that the Social Security Administrator shall reimburse the U.S. Internal Revenue Service for its expenses incurred in performing services in such administration, collection, assessment, and enforcement.
