## TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION 4: EMPLOYMENT AND REGISTRATION

## § 4941. Complaints and Actions in Labor Matters.

- (a) *Individual complaints*. Any foreign national worker who is aggrieved by the failure or refusal of his or her employer to comply with an approved employment contract may make a complaint to the Department. Any employer of a foreign national worker who is aggrieved by the failure or refusal of his or her employee to comply with an approved employment contract may make a complaint to the Department.
- (b) *Department actions*. The Department may commence an action against an employer or a foreign national worker for an alleged violation of the labor or wage laws of the Commonwealth.
- (c) *Court actions*. The Attorney General, at the request of the Secretary, may institute an action in any court of competent jurisdiction for a temporary restraining order, injunction, or other appropriate remedy to enforce any provision of this chapter.
