§ 3103. Board of Professional Licensing Tenure; Officers; Vacancies.

The members of the Board shall serve for six years. The officers of the Board shall be elected every two years. The Board shall elect, by the majority vote of a quorum of its members, a Chairperson, a Vice-chairperson, and a Secretary. In the event of a vacancy on the Board for reason resulting in an unexpired term and the governor has failed to appoint a successor within three months after the vacancy occurs, the Board may appoint a provisional member to serve in the interim until the governor makes an appointment.
