TITLE 4: ECONOMIC RESOURCES DIVISION 8: UTILITIES

§ 8145. Reconnection of Utility Services.

- (a) Fees. The corporation shall charge a reconnection fee of \$25.00 for water utility services and \$25.00 for electric utility service for residential consumers. In the event both electrical and water services for residential consumers are disconnected at the same time due to nonpayment of both services, the reconnection fee for both electrical and water services shall be \$25.00 for the reconnection of both services. The reconnection fee for electrical or water services for commercial consumers shall be \$75.00 for each service.
- (b) Reconnection security deposit. CUC shall not require an additional security deposit to reconnect a residential customer's utility service that is greater than the security deposit required for new residential utility service applicants.
